With the amount of snow expected, the contractor will do their best to clear roadways as quickly, efficiently and thoroughly as possible and try to avoid "berming" in driveways. We ask that you help the contractor by not parking on the street and be patient as snow removal will take time with this type of storm.

To minimize wear and tear and potential damage to our gates, we have decided to power them down and leave them in the open position for the duration of this storm. This affects both the Forest Hills Drive and Eastwood gates. Once we ensure there is no snow blocking normal gate operation, we will power them back up.

As a reminder, please stay off of all ponds in the District. With the warm weather we've been having, the ice under all the snow that is expected is not stable or very think. Looks can be deceiving.
