FISHING PERMIT PROCEDURE

Adopted May 2014

A Fishing Permit (Daily Use) will be issued to individuals who show a copy of a valid Colorado fishing license and pay a \$5.00 minimum fee per day. Applications on a District form are to be sent to the District Manager who will process the permit. Children under the age of 13 are not required to have a permit if they are accompanied by a permitted adult.

Special Rules for Residents:

- Permit fees for residents will be added to a resident's Utility Bill statement. All other permit applicants must pay by check or cash.
- Because residents pay water and sewer fees, which support the operation and maintenance of the District's ponds, residents must only pay one permit fee per year. Further daily fees are considered to be covered by the resident's water and sewer fees.
